day of the year.





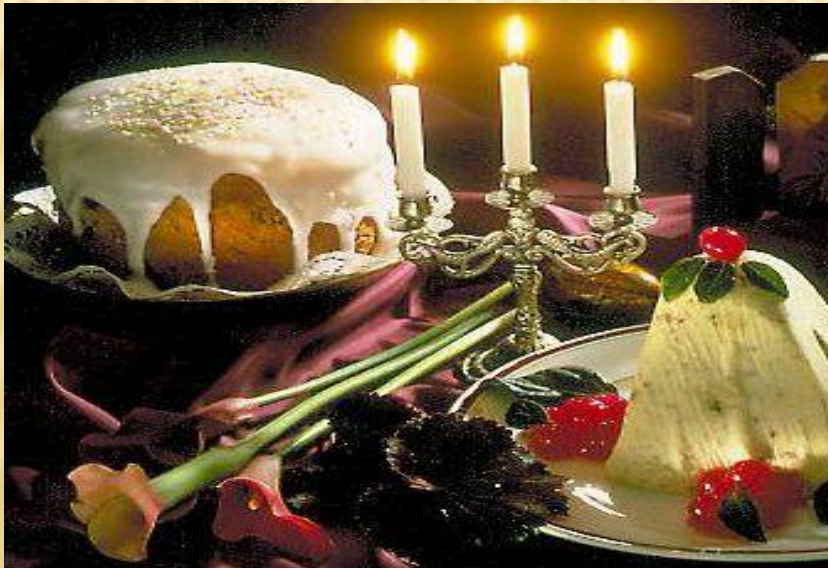
Valentine's Day
